

How to have a 30 or 60 minute radio program on the AT Radio Network {Atradio.net}

Some questions are -

How much will it cost?

How can you be sure that the programs that people send to be played will be approved of God?

Will you have someone listen to every single program before it is aired?

Will the programs be limited to Bible approved religious messages, or can a person send something secular like "Leave it to Beaver?"

If a person has things that he wants to sell - like books, sermon tapes, health tapes, music tapes, health food, cars, houses, clothes, property, or anything else that he thinks that God would approve of, can he advertise them?

What about music? Is there a standard that will be followed? Does the prophet give such a standard?

When a person sends his program to be aired, will it be aired only once, or will it be aired every day at the same time for a week, or for a whole month for the same price?

The answers are -

1) Programs aired on the AT radio network will be limited to Bible-based, religious programs that are true to God's SDA Bible teachings.

2) To have your radio program aired -

A - Make it on either a cassette tape or a CD.

B - Mail it to us with the check to cover the air time, to

C - If you prefer to use a credit card, you may call Pastor Jan's office at 618-627-2357 to do that.

D - Your programs will need to be either 30 or 60 minutes - right on the dot to within 10 seconds. If you have a musical intro and ending, record them within the 30 or 60 minutes.

3) Each program will be carefully listened to before it is aired. If there is any segment of it that is not in harmony with the Bible and Spirit of Prophecy, the "listener" will send the program back to you with a note concerning the segment. After the correction, the program may be re-submitted. If a majority of the entire program is not in harmony with Isa. 8:20; Rev. 12:17; & Rev. 19:10, it will be kindly returned, to be exchanged for one which is.

4) Programs on the AT radio network will be placed in the schedule on a first come, first serve

basis. Please check the schedule to see what time slots are available, and choose whatever one you wish. Your programs will replace Pastor Jan's Revelation series, so you need not be concerned about placing your program where one of those programs are. Your program will replace it.

Keep in mind that good time slots will differ in different areas. A program with a good time slot in Washington D.C. will be aired at an odd time in London, Australia, China, Japan, Russia, or South Africa. A time slot at 7 p.m. in Los Angeles will be 10 p.m. on the east coast. 8 a.m. in Virginia will be 5 a.m. in Oregon. So the Lord will guide you.

5) Though the AT Radio Network may be heard via satellite in any nation on earth where a person has an internet connection, the cost will be the same as it was on the local religious radio station in Homosassa Springs, Florida in 1981. What was that? It was \$1 per minute. But you may like the AT Radio Network even more because the Florida station charged \$30 for a 30 minute program to be aired only one time. For a 60 minute program they charged \$60, and aired it only once. That was it. On the AT Radio Network, your 30 or 60 minute program will be aired every day of the week at the same time each day for an entire month!

If it starts on Thursday, June 5, at 7 p.m. eastern time, the last time it will be aired will be Friday, July 4 at 7 p.m. Keep in mind that some months are longer than others. We will go by however long the month is that your program is aired.

The more people you tell about the time and place of your program on ATradio.net, the more people will be able to hear it. And the more people who inform others about the AT Radio Network at ATradio.net, the more people will hear your program.

If a person wants to sell something that he thinks that God would approve of, can he advertise it? The answer is yes. That will be part of what the "listener" will listen to and approve or disapprove.

But a person shouldn't judge the success of his program on what he does or does not sell, because, since this is a religious station, and not a commercial station, people may be getting far more of a blessing from his Bible-based message than from what he advertises.

6) What about music in the program? Is there a standard that will be followed? Does the prophet give such a standard? Here it is -

"Music should have beauty, pathos, and power. Call to your aid, if practicable, instrumental music, and let the glorious harmony ascend to God, an acceptable offering. . . Some think that the louder they sing the more music they make; but noise is not music. Good singing is like the music of the birds – subdued and melodious.

"The long-drawn-out notes and the peculiar sounds common in operatic singing are not pleasing to the angels. They delight to hear the simple songs of praise sung in a natural tone. The songs in which every word is uttered clearly, in a musical tone, are the songs that they join us in singing. They take up the refrain that is sung from the heart with the spirit and the understanding." *The Voice and Speech in Song*, pp. 415, 416.

Notice the elements of music that God approves of - 1) beauty, 2) pathos, 3) power, 4) glorious harmony, 5) simple songs in a natural tone, 6) every word uttered clearly, 7) from the heart.

Much music has a lot of power, but not much beauty, and certainly no pathos. Pathos touches the heart with a welling up of love and great reverence to God. Much modern religious music

produces irreverence, and does no more for the people's souls than seeing a nicely decorated junk yard.

To find music with the above listed 7 elements is so rare that most people have hardly ever heard such music in their entire lives! But this is the type of music the AT Radio Network will approve.

This is the kind of music that we are airing now. We have it playing seven days a week, every three hours around the clock, starting at 12 a.m. Eastern time.

7) I joyfully anticipate the happiness that will come to those who make and air their radio programs - with the prayers and hopes that because of them, precious souls will enjoy the wonders and peace of heaven with the lovely Jesus forever!
